Purpose of Meeting

To discuss budgeting items for the 2023 budget.

Present

Utilities/Streets – Casey Boggs

- Water tower cleaning - \$4000-\$5000
- An overhaul of the water plant pumps - \$\$2000-\$6000
- New Toolcat and bucket – approx. \$43,000
- Second mower - \$13,000
- Repairs to Utility Truck (Jonah’s)
- The pickup will need to be replaced but can possibly be replaced in 2024.
- Casey requested up to 8% raises for himself and his staff.
 - Council asked where staff is on obtaining water and sewer certifications. If obtained, as previously agreed, staff would receive an additional one dollar per hour raise.

Pierceton Police Department – Tim Sammons


- 2 vests – grant closes at end of July
- Possible JAG grant to hire additional officers
- Tim would like to discuss further vehicle replacement options including a possible leasing program.
- Raise for Deputy Marshal. No amount provided as to how much of a raise. Tim was advised that the town would want to keep additional funds available for another full-time officer or multiple part-time officers and not invest full budget in one officer. Tim will prepare numbers to pass onto Matt Brubaker regarding the raise.

Clerk – Myra Mast


- Election charges in the - \$2500.
