Purpose of Meeting

To revisit issues that need attention prior to the December regular council meeting.

Present

Approval of Minutes

The minutes for the Public Hearing regarding the Sidewalk Project that was held on November 11, 2023, at 6:30 pm were approved.

Surf Internet

- Surf Internet will provide a \$10,000 performance bond.
- There will be an emergency internal civil crew on call 24 hours a day.
- Crews will start the week of December 4, 2023.
- Janet Castle motioned to approve Surf Internet's request to move forward with installation of the fiber internet in the town.

Ashley Ryman

- Seeking to gain the town's support in the process of obtaining a supplemental 210 alcohol permit for Kaleidoscope (formerly the United Methodist Church Building).
 - The license would be for the business only and is not transferable to any other business but the wedding venue.
 - With the license, the owners will be able to control the amount of alcohol that is consumed at each event.
 - The business is pushing for July 2024 as their first event.
 - The council would like a letter of support submitted to Matt Sandy at Area Plan and a copy to Ashley Ryman.

Deputy Clerk Salary

- Kelly Engle has agreed to come back to work in the clerk's office.
- Resolution 11-1-23 was approved to set her full-time wage at \$18 an hour, her insurance benefits will be effective December 4, 2023, when she resumes her full-

time employment, and her vacation will resume on her original full-time employment date of January 1.

Other Business


- Council denied a request to allow the builder of a new home in Pierceton to delay the payment of the tap fees until after the home sells.
- Casey Boggs submitted a request to the council to allow a Pierceton resident to put up a fence around his business and stated it would not interfere with the town utilities. Council stated they had no issue with it if the resident abides by the county ordinance.
